What is AssetPlatform.org?

- **AssetPlatform.org** is a new resource for staff at nonprofit organizations that provides financial education, coaching and asset development services.
- **AssetPlatform** delivers high quality, affordable and easily accessible products and services to the desktops of front-line staff, so they can more effectively serve their communities, including:
 - ✓ *Training, calculators, assessment tools, consumer-friendly financial products and links to experts*

How is AssetPlatform.org organized?

- **AssetPlatform.org** is organized around six primary categories of resources:
 1. *Budgeting*
 2. *Savings*
 3. *Credit Score*
 4. *Debt*
 5. *Insurance*
 6. *Organizational Resources*

Each category contains a variety of relevant training, tools and products.
